About CLASS

The CESA 2 Licensure Academy for School Staff (CLASS) program is a Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) approved alternative pathway to teacher licensure in the state of Wisconsin. The CLASS program provides formal instruction in the planning and delivery of effective instructional practices, assessment of students' progress, classroom management, and educational technology implemented during your teaching experience in order for candidates to meet the requirements of initial or add-on teaching licenses in the state of Wisconsin.







How to enroll in CLASS

- 1. Review CLASS information on www.cesa2.org.
- 2. Complete the CLASS Enrollment Form.
- 3. Complete CLASS background check.
- **4.** CLASS staff will review your application materials and contact you within 2 business days.
- **5.** Meet with CLASS staff to create your Individual Licensure Agreement. Determine your program completion timeline and payment schedule.
- **6.** After the Individual Licensure Agreement meeting:
- Make your first payment
- Sign and return your Individual Licensure Agreement.
- **7.** CLASS is in session! Meet your CLASS instructors and begin online coursework, live individual coaching sessions, and clinical teaching requirements.
