Description: Teach Driver's Education in the classroom and/or behind the wheel to high school students. Multiple locations in the CESA 2 region may be required. An asset to the position is the flexibility the teacher has in scheduling the BTW lessons and working independently.

CESA 2 has a DPI approved teacher licensing program in Driver Education which is free for CESA 2 employees. In order to be considered, the candidate must have a DPI approved teaching license in another subject area
